KENAITZE INDIAN TRIBE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL Kalifornsky Village Gravesite Environmental Risk Assessment

Question and Answers Issued: 2/09/2024

- 1. The RFP presents two options for a plan (protect in place or relocation). Does the Kenaitze Indian Tribe (Tribe) have a preference for one or the other? At this time, the Tribe does not have a preference; this is a research and planning grant, and the final decisions will depend on the family's preference for their ancestors.
- 2. Would the Tribe entertain an option to relocate graves at risk while leaving others? Yes.
- 3. Does the Tribe have in mind or selected a location for the potential reinternment of their ancestors? Yes, the Tribe has options if that is the route we choose.
- 4. Can the Tribe share the currently available funds for the requested work, or provide a dollar amount that they expect to be available for this work? Not at this time.
- 5. Will the Tribe share copies of the 2005 and 2006 reports (with any sensitive data redacted)? Yes, they will be provided upon award.
- 6. Section 7.1 of the RFP assumes that all staff working on the project share the same rate per hour. Will the Tribe accept a cost proposal that follows the requested formula but which presents labor categories with different rates? Yes.
- 7. Can the Tribe share a copy of a template contract so that our risk team may review? An early review of the proposed contract language would facilitate an expedited notice-to-proceed should we be selected as the successful vendor. Yes, please find a Draft version attached. Several elements, such as Scope of Work and Schedule, are still TBD. Feel free to redline and submit with your proposal. (Not required but encouraged).
