# **Tribal Scholarship Guidelines**

### <u>Eligibility</u>

To be eligible for the Tribal Scholarship, an applicant must be:

- A member of Kenaitze Indian Tribe.
- Enrolled in an accredited college, university, or trade school and are pursuing a degree/certificate/certification.
- Continuing undergraduate applicants who meet the academic requirements will be funded first.
- All other undergraduate students will be funded on first-come, first-serve basis until all funds are expended.
- Summer school students may be funded if funds are available.
- Graduate Students may be funded if funds are available and all other funding sources have been exhausted.

#### Academic Requirements:

• Students must maintain an minimum of a 2.0 grade point average (GPA).

#### Academic Probation/Suspension:

- If a student does not meet the required cumulative GPA or withdraws from a degree/certificate seeking program, they may be placed on Academic Probation for one term. The expectation is that the student will return to their previous degree/certificate seeking status and maintain a 2.5 GPA for the following term.
- Once a students funding has been suspended, the student will not be considered for future funding until the student, **through other funding sources**, earns a minimum a 2.5 GPA for the term in which he/she is enrolled.

#### **Notice and Payment of Award:**

- Kenaitze Indian Tribe will notify applicants in writing within 30 days after all paperwork is submitted. Notification will specify the award amount.
- Payments of scholarships will be made to the financial aid office at the college or university the student is attending
- If a student does not enter, or drops from the institution, the institution shall refund all the remaining fund to the Kenaitze Indian Tribe.

#### **Recommendations:**

- All applicants must complete and submit a financial aid package to the Kenaitze Indian Tribe as soon as possible to enhance funding possibilities.
- All students must send or have the college/university send the grade transcripts as soon as possible after each term so as not to delay next term's funding.
